Specialist Therapy Sessions



At Langdon College, Speech and Language Therapists (SLTs) and Occupational Therapists (OT) work with students to develop highly individualised and person-centred communication targets and therapy programmes, which connect to functional and meaningful aspects of the young person's life.

We work jointly with teaching staff, other therapists and parents to ensure targets are embedded across the college day, on placements and at home, where possible, to support generalisation and functionality of skills.

News

Following Government guidelines Langdon College are helping to keep learners and their families safe by offering lateral flow testing twice a week. Lateral flow testing is currently being offered to people who do not have symptoms, in a range of different settings. Lateral flow device (LFD) testing is a fast and simple way to test people who do not have symptoms of COVID-19, but who may still be spreading the virus. The tests are easy to use and give results in 30 minutes.



Independent Living

Independent Living Skills are at the core of our curriculum. Last week the learners learnt how to make hamantaschen for the colleges Purim celebrations. The learners used the milchik training kitchen to prepare the ingredients, then make and bake the hamantaschen.
