Handwriting is a complex process and is not as simple as people think. Poor fine motor skills can be a sign of weak hand strength and grip. Learners have been completing finger strengthening exercises with resistance Theraputty and using a Cross Guard grip on pens.

The aim is by building learners hand strength they will gain more independence with form filling and legibility for their future.

Jewish Studies


